

Pancake vortices in one layer of a layered high-temperature superconductor are visualised as blue spheres. They repel each other and form a hexagonal lattice, which is disturbed due to thermal fluctuations. The potential energy from interactions with pancakes in other layers is visualised through the green energy surface and stabilises the lattice.

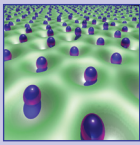

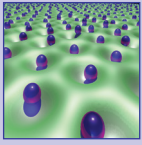
Location

Exhibition

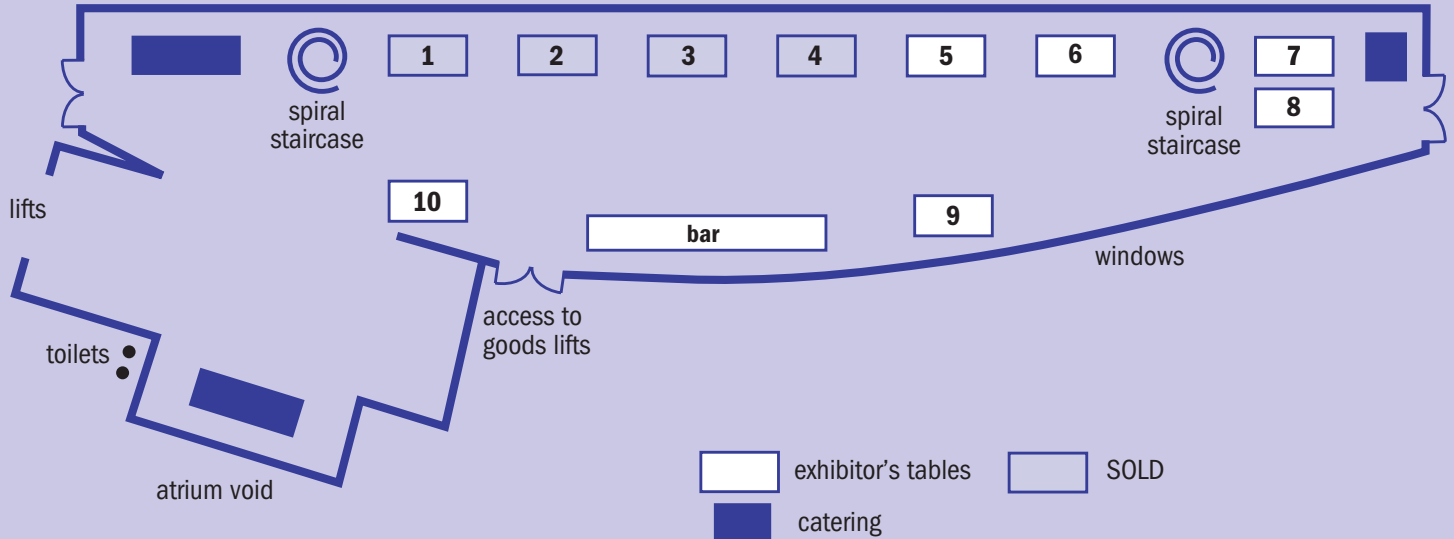
